## Memorial Holocaust Art & Writing Contest

### THIS YEAR'S THEME: Heroes of the Holocaust

*Write or create an art piece about someone that you view as a hero from the Holocaust. This hero could be a resistor, a rescuer, a liberator, a role model or a survivor.*

#### DEADLINES

- » Writing submissions are due by **Friday, March 9, 2018.**
- » Art submissions are due by **Friday, March 16, 2018.**

The contest is open to **grades 5–8** (Division I) and **9–12** (Division II), public, parochial, or home schooled in the Miami Valley (OH).

#### AWARDS

Awards for both art and writing will be announced at the Greater Dayton Yom Hashoah Observance on **April 8, 2018, at Beth Jacob Synagogue at 4PM.** Art entries will be on display immediately preceding and following the program. For both art and writing, there will be cash awards and certificates given to first, second, third place and honorable mention pieces.

#### For both art & writing, each entry:

- › Must represent the independent effort of the artist/writer
- › Will be judged on originality, content and appearance
- › Remains the property of the Holocaust Education Committee, which reserves the right to publish the entry in its entirety

#### WRITING

Fiction, Nonfiction, Poetry and Drama. Poetry and Prose will be judged separately.

#### Each Entry:

- › Cannot exceed 2,000 words
- › Must be typed or printed, double spaced, on one side of the paper
- › If mailing a hard copy, please include a cover page and three copies for the judges' use
- › The cover page must include the following information:

  - » Grade
  - » Name of School
  - » Name of Teacher
  - » Teacher Email
