Third Question


Why is it that on all other nights we do not dip even once, but on this night we dip twice?

Why is it that on all other nights we eat either sitting or reclining, but on this night we eat in a reclining position?




























Directions: Cut along the solid lines and fold along the dotted middle line with pictures facing outward. Use tape or glue to form a ring with the horizontal tabs.
