- A daily group reading experience for exposure to the written word in somewhat of a predictable pattern:
- Greeting - date - 3 sentences about our day
- This is a great opportunity to focus on letter recognition
- We will take turns circling a specific letter in the message and discuss things like punctuation

<p>Tuesday</p>	<p>Book: Reread Bear Shadow</p> <p>Daily Graph/Question: Can you really play hide and seek with your shadow?</p> <p>Activites: 1.) Fun with shadows- Trace shadow (objects and our own shadow) with chalk and see if they change 2.) Play shadow tag</p>
<p>Wednesday</p>	<p>Book: Moon Cake</p> <p>Daily Graph/Question: Would you like to go to the moon? What do you think you'd see?</p> <p>Activities: 1.) Build and color (by sounds) a rocket ship for Bear to go to the moon. 2.) Identify letters, sounds, and object names.</p>
<p>Thursday</p>	<p>Books: Moon Cake</p> <p>Daily Graph/Question: Where would you go in your own rocket , other than the moon?</p> <p>Activities: 1.) Write about a place you want to go in your rocket. Would you go to one place or multiple places? 2.) Count Down to Blast Off - Using numbers 1-10 make a backward sequence to count down</p>
